FINCH MATCHING PROGRAM

Another big thank you to our members for all donations given, including those that were submitted and matched through the Finch Match My Donation program. To date we have received \$3,046.30 from the matching. All thanks to our members, family and friends. This is a big contributor to our ability to purchase yarn to provide to our members to make the blankets. Every donation really does matter. Your generosity is felt and will go a long way.

GRANTS RECEIVED:

We received a grant from the *Farmer's Grow Communities* for \$2,500.
